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Dear Parent,

Your child is zoned for Auburndale Central Elementary, which receives federal Title I funds to assist students in meeting state achievement standards for Adequate Yearly Progress (AYP). Because your child's school did not meet these standards for two or more years, it has been identified as a *School in Need of Improvement*. This designation alone does not indicate a failing school, but provides a focus on areas for school improvement by principals, teachers, and parents.

What are your School Choice options?

Under the federal No Child Left Behind (NCLB) law, when a school has been identified as a *School in Need of Improvement*, parents will have options for the following school year in 2009-2010:

- You may choose to have your child remain at the current school.
- If your child is eligible for free or reduced-priced lunch, you may choose for your child to remain at the current school and apply to receive free tutoring "Supplemental Educational Services". We will send you additional information about free tutoring during the summer, along with a separate application.
- You may choose to apply to transfer your child to one of the schools listed below. If demand for School Choice exceeds available funds, by law, placement and transportation will be prioritized to the lowest achieving low-income students.

If you want to apply to transfer your child to another public school, your school options are as follows:

Lake Alfred El.	07/08 School Grade A	Met 100% of AYP standards
Polk City El.	07/08 School Grade B	Met 100% of AYP standards
Auburndale Central Elementary	07/08 School Grade C	Met 90% of AYP standards
