Florida Statute

1008.345 **Implementation of state system of school improvement and education accountability.—**

(d) The department shall assign a community assessment team to each school district with a school designated as performance grade category "D" or "F" to review the school performance data and determine causes for the low performance. The team shall make recommendations to the school board, to the department, and to the State Board of Education for implementing an assistance and intervention plan that will address the causes of the school's low performance. The assessment team shall include, but not be limited to, a department representative, parents, business representatives, educators, and community activists, and shall represent the demographics of the community from which they are appointed.

Expectation

- The Committee will consist of an Education Community Leader, a Business Community Leader, an outstanding student, and a parent who currently is an active member of your School Advisory Council.
- The Committee will implement a plan to resolve equity issues.
- The Department of Education will facilitate the Community Oversight Committee visits observing the implementation of the school improvement and district assistance and intervention plans reporting their observations to the school, the district, and the State Department of Education.
- The Community Oversight Committee will meet quarterly and provide a report to the Department of Education. The reports are due to the state on November 30, 2005, February 28, 2006, and May 31, 2006.
